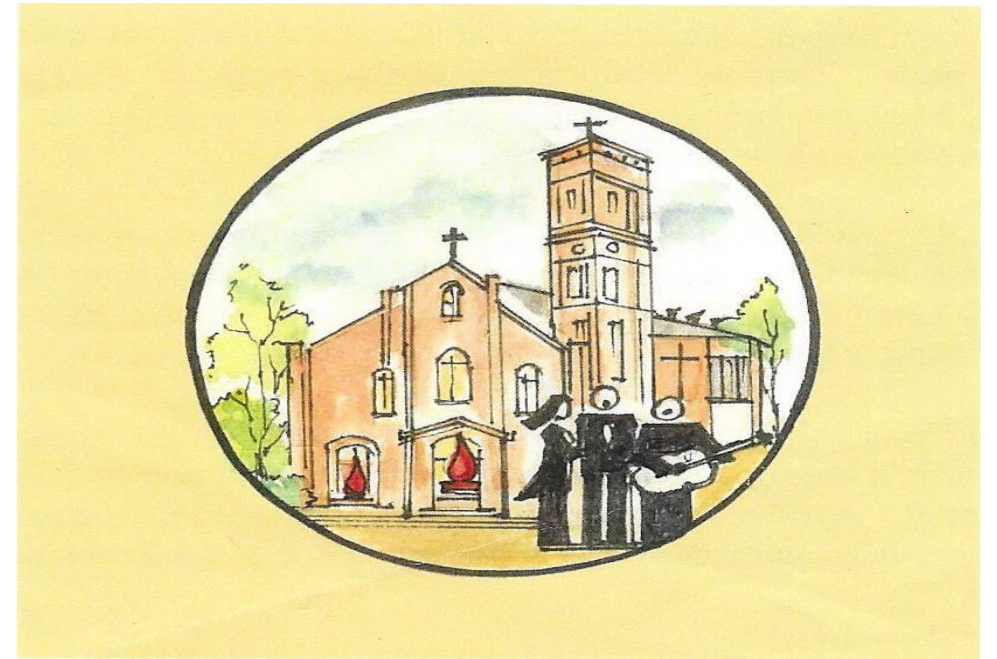

ONE YEAR DOWN, TWO YEARS TO GO

In June of last year we entered into our Boiler Capital Campaign Project at St. Paul's Parish. Now, one year later, our campaign pledges have totaled \$325,906.25, the amount collected from the pledges has reached \$216,446.25, leaving \$109,460.00 still outstanding with two years still remaining in our three year campaign.

All three communities in our parish have contributed to the success of our campaign as we now move into the second year of our boiler project. Thank you, gracias, cam on.
